The following policies are considered part of the Use Agreement for SSDC.

1. Minimum Group Leaders/participants is one to 5. Group leaders should be 18 years of age or older.
2. SSDC has no medical staff on duty. Each group is responsible for its own medical and emergency needs and should provide at least one person with current CPR and First Aid training. It is recommended that each group bring health information for all participants including names, addresses, emergency contact information, known allergies, extenuating health conditions and signed permission to treat forms for all minors.
3. Although SSDC does provide program staff for various activities, group leaders are responsible for supervision and behavior management.
4. No cabin campfires allowed.
5. Smoking and or use of tobacco products is strictly prohibited at all SSDC functions.
6. Alcoholic beverages, fireworks, weapons, firearms, hunting, ATV's and personal pets are strictly prohibited.
7. Please conserve energy resources by turning off lights, turning off showers and sinks, and keeping doors closed on any building that has air conditioning.
8. Please keep the campground and buildings free of paper and other trash.
9. Boys are not permitted in girl cabins and girls are not permitted in boy cabins.
10. Please leave cabins in a clean condition. Brooms and cleaning supplies are stored in the cabins. If excessive cleaning is necessary, it may result in additional costs.
11. All damages to camp property will be the responsibility of the group, school, or organization.
12. No driving of vehicles in restricted areas is allowed.
13. Weather conditions determine which activities are available. No discounts or refunds are given in the event that an activity is not available. Alternate indoor activities will be provided in case of bad weather.
14. Lost and found items are donated to charitable organizations if not claimed within two weeks of camp ending.
15. To facilitate meals, please be on time as per listed meal times. In the event an activity is running longer than expected arrangements will be made for meals.
16. Upon arrival please keep the students in, or near, the bus and have one Group leader from each bus meet with SSDC staff for brief orientation.
